My beautiful husband and father of our four children, Neill Openshaw, died on 1st January 2014, following a cerebral aneurysm. He was 49 years old.

Neill was an Orthopaedic Surgeon with a thriving practice in Bunbury, Western Australia. He was fit, healthy and loved his life. His four children, Emma, Charlotte, Kate and Henry adored him. We were months away from celebrating our 25th Wedding Anniversary.

Without warning, Neill collapsed at home on the morning of New Year's Eve. He was flown to Perth where we received the devastating news that he could not recover. As a family, we suggested he could become an organ donor.

Neill has given new life to four people, with his kidneys, lungs and liver all being successfully transplanted. We miss him more than words can ever say. He is our hero.
